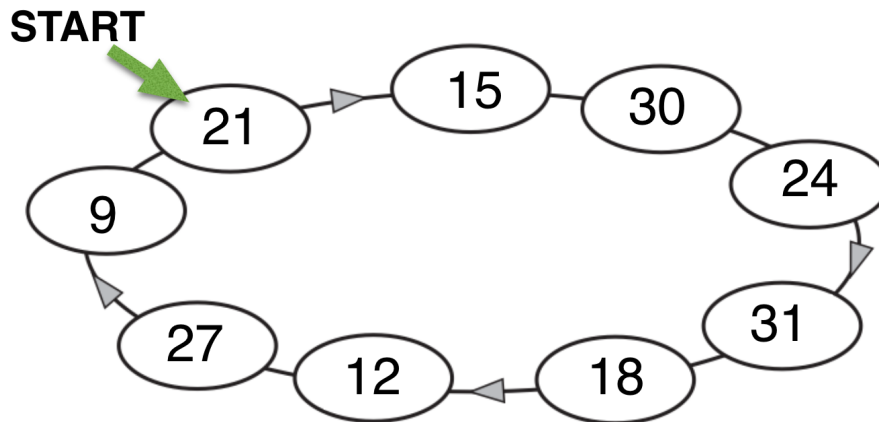


Three in a Line – The Game of Remainders (4)

How to Play – Put one counter the **START** space on the wheel. Following the arrows, Player A moves one space or 2 spaces, and **divides that number by 4**. Player A puts a counter in their colour on the **number of remainders** in the grid below.

For example, if she lands on 15, then $15 \div 4 = 3 R 3$. Player A covers a 3 on the grid below.

Player B **continues** to move around the wheel, moving either one space or 2 spaces, and covers their total remainders in their colour. Three in a line in a colour wins!
